	Average Registered	Average Actual	% Registered Actually Attended
All Meetings	20	11	52%
Sr. Standing Committees	36	25	69%
Standing Committees	20	10	48%
Sr. Task Forces	18	4	22%

- Attendance at Sr. Standing Committees and Standing Committees higher than Sr. Task Forces
- Stakeholder actual attendance vis-à-vis registration is low
- Attendance in summer and fall, as well as first two months of 2023 very similar
- Stakeholder Attendance at Sr. Task Force meeting has been very low

- Sr. Standing Committee and Standing Committee meetings will retain in-person attendance option
- Sr. Task Force meetings will be handled differently than they have been:
 - Generally Sr. Task Force meetings will be virtual only
 - Option will be available for in-person attendance if the subject matter or phase of the process warrants (e.g. as an issue moves to packages and negotiation)
- The Critical Issue Fast Path – Resource Adequacy meetings will retain an in-person attendance option
