



PJM Seams (M2M) Update – Posting Congestion Management Process Materials for Stakeholder Review

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- Purpose
 - This presentation provides an informational update on PJM's efforts to be ensure transparency with respect to Seams Coordination activities
- Background
 - PJM and MISO have received feedback from our respective and joint stakeholders to be more transparent in PJM's Seams Coordination activities
 - Stakeholders have explicitly identified that providing insights to the Congestion Management Process activities would be beneficial

- PJM belongs to a Congestion Management Process (CMP) established by 7 organizations – PJM, MISO, SPP, TVA, MAPP, Manitoba Hydro & WAPA
- CMP is established to manage Seams Constrained Facilities adhering to following guiding principles:
 - Reliability
 - Coordination
 - Market Efficiency
 - Equity

- There are three different CMP relationships
 - Market to Market (ex: MISO-PJM)
 - Market to non-Market (ex: PJM-TVA)
 - non-Market to non-Market (ex: MAPP-Manitoba Hydro)
- In order to manage CMP activities, relationships and principles
 - Joint Operating Agreements are established
 - Congestion Management Process Working Group is established
 - Congestion Management Process Council is established

- Relationship between CMPWG and CMPC is analogous to MIC Special Task Force and MIC
 - CMPWG is directed by the CMPC to work on seams initiatives/tasks
 - CMPC provides direction and priority to the CMPWG initiatives/tasks
 - CMPWG will report back to CMPC on their progress

- PJM during the MIC sessions and during the JCM sessions provide updates to stakeholders with respect to explicit CMP initiatives/tasks
 - Freeze Date Alternatives
 - PJM-MISO JOA changes
- In order to increase transparency PJM will begin to publish CMPC and CMPWG items
 - CMPC Meeting Notes
 - CMPC Future Agenda Items
 - CMPWG Future Agenda Items

- PJM has begun to post CMP materials in PJM.COM
 - Operations & Markets -> Market to Markets -> Congestion Management Process Information
