Administration

- 1. Ms. Adrien Ford and Ms. Christina Stotesbury provided announcements and reviewed the Anti-trust, Code of Conduct and Media Participation policies.
- 2. Minutes from the April 8, 2015 Market Implementation Committee meeting were approved as posted.

4. **PJM Net Assets**

Ms. Janell Fabiano, PJM, and Ms. Suzanne Daugherty, PJM, reviewed the Tariff Harmonization Senior Task Force initiative and presented the proposed definition of Net Assets.

5. Erie Operations Update

Mr. Joe Ciabattoni, PJM, provided an update on the Erie emergency and DR operations that occurred April 21 and 22.

6. Pricing Interfaces

Mr. Joe Ciabattoni, PJM, reviewed the ERIE-PN and PENELEC Closed Loop Interfaces that were created to support thermal and/or voltage conditions. Pricing Interface Definitions

7. Billing Adjustment

Ms. Suzanne Daugherty, PJM, notified the Committee that incorrect Lost Opportunity Cost (LOC) payments have been identified due to what appears to be incorrect or incomplete forced outage reporting to PJM by some generators and estimated the adjustment will not exceed \$15 million for all generators combined. Ms. Daugherty suggested generation owners review if they received LOC payments during a forced outrage throughout the past 24 months, April 2013 – April 2015. PJM will be reaching out to affected members prior to processing billing adjustments.

8. Member Update

Ms. Suzanne Daugherty, PJM, notified the Committee that PJM has declared Intergrid Mideast Group, LLC in both collateral and payment default. PJM will file with the FERC to permanently terminate their membership. The defaulting PJM member, Intergrid Mideast, holds FTR positions for May 2015 as well as the 15/16, 16/17, and 17/18 planning periods. PJM will attempt to liquidate the FTR positions effective from June 1, 2015 forward in accordance with Section 7.3.9 of the PJM Operating Agreement. The FTR positions that will be offered for sale along with more detailed information are available on the <u>PJM FTR website</u>. Until those FTR positions are liquidated, it is not possible for PJM to estimate what, if any, default allocation assessments may result from Intergrid Mideast's default.

9. Update on Capacity Performance and the Base Residual Auction Waiver (10:10 – 10:20)

Mr. Jeff Bastian, PJM, provided an update on Capacity Performance and the Base Residual Auction Waiver. PJM expects FERC to rule on the Capacity Performance filing by no later than June 9, 2015.
