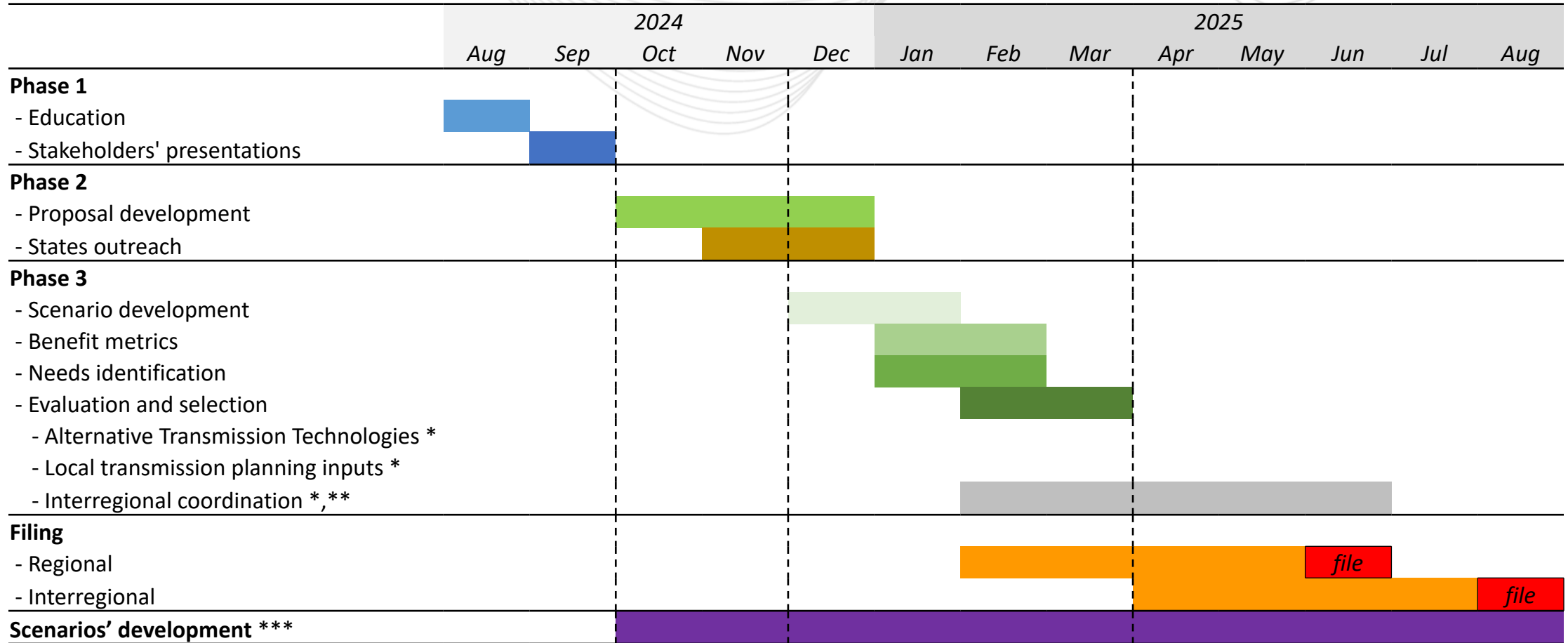
Special TEAC – Order 1920

- Effective on August 12, 2024
- Addresses the following long-term planning topics:
 - Scenario development
 - Benefit metrics
 - Evaluation and selection
 - Alternative Transmission Technologies
 - Cost allocation
 - Coordination of Order No. 1000 and generator interconnection processes
 - Local transmission planning inputs in LTRTP
 - Interregional transmission coordination

- Two separate filings
 - a. Regional (due by June 12, 2025)
 - b. Interregional (due by August 12, 2025)
- PJM compliance activities related to states and stakeholders
 1. PJM-led stakeholder engagement on Order No. 1920
 2. PJM outreach to states
 3. Scenarios' development for first LTRTP cycle

 - *Policy modeling across scenarios*
 - *Non-policy related retirements*
 - **Benefit metrics**
 - **Use of multiple scenarios** for need identification, evaluation, selection
 - **Alternative Transmission Technologies**
 - **Project selection criteria** (Order does not require PJM to select projects)
