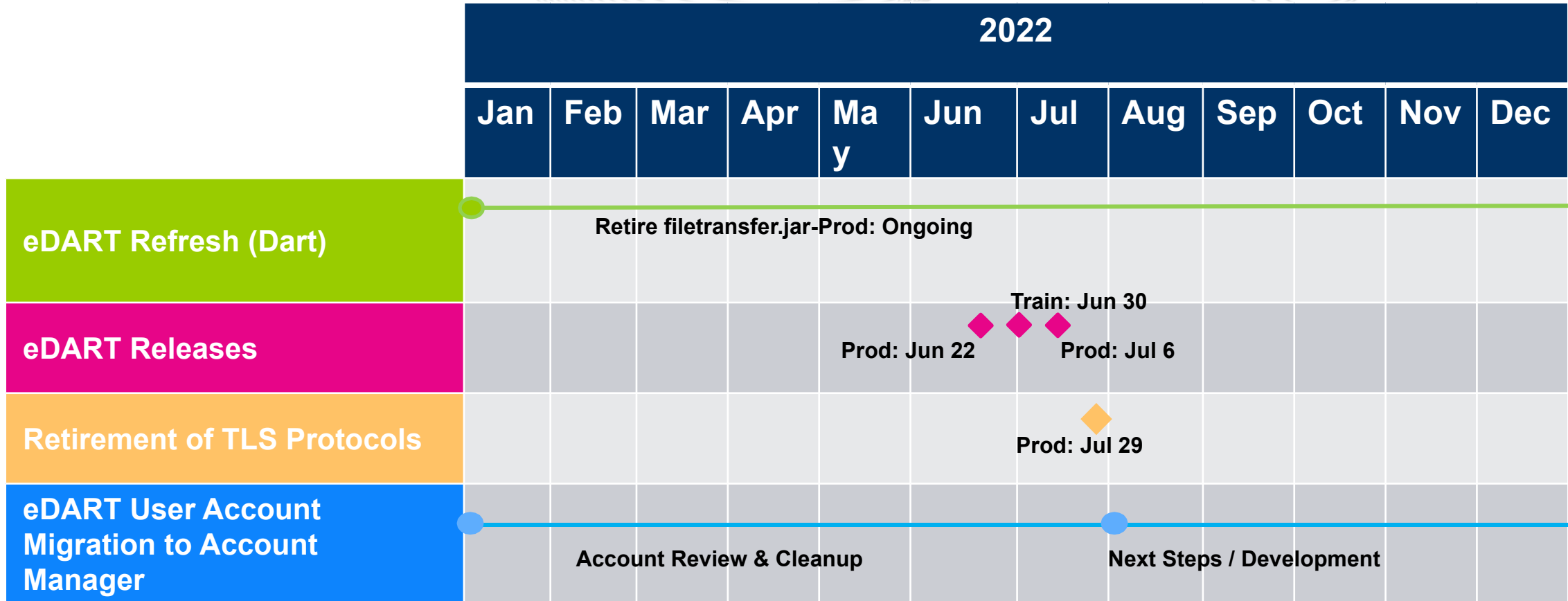

- Enhancements to CDW Unit Groups functionality
- New business rules added for Power Factor Voltage Schedules
- TERM acknowledgement enhancements
  - New filter for ticket status
  - Option to Check All/Select All

## PJM will retire TLS 1.0 and TLS 1.1 protocols

- Production implementation on **July 29**
- Impacts users accessing eDART or eDART files on pjm.com via web browser using TLS 1.0 and/or TLS 1.1 protocols
- **Actions Required**: Review [Weak Encryption Remediation Guide](#) and make necessary changes
- eDART team will contact logged in users that access eDART via a web browser using TLS 1.0 and/or TLS 1.1 protocols (with exception of public files)
- Additional resource: Tech Change Forum [Special Session on Retiring Weak Encryption](#)

With the eDART refresh, management of eDART user accounts will be migrated to Account Manager.

- Implementation Timeline: TBD
- Account Manager will be used for all new eDART account requests
- Plans currently underway to:
  - Review existing eDART accounts and update email addresses
  - Clean up dormant and invalid accounts
  - Work with eDART Company Account Managers (CAMs)
    - Review window: **Q1/2022 – Q3/2022**
