Issue Source

PJM and Curtailment Service Providers. The new CP DR tariff language was unintentionally written in a way that imposes additional requirements for new non-summer capacity compliance measurement and verification.

Stakeholder Group Assignment

MIC with support from DRS as necessary.

Key Work Activities

Propose new tariff and manual language to clarify how CBLs (which will be used to measure non-summer capacity compliance) will be determined for Emergency/Pre-Emergency DR registrations.

Expected Deliverables

Propose new tariff and manual language to clarify how CBLs will be determined for Emergency/Pre-Emergency DR registrations. File new tariff language with FERC for approval

Expected Overall Duration of Work

File tariff changes at FERC no later than March 2016 to receive a decision before start of Delivery Year.

Decision-Making Method

Tier 1, consensus (unanimity) on a single proposal (preferred default option). PJM believes this is a clarification to existing tariff language which is in line with intention of market rule change.
