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Capacity Capability Senior Task Force

- FERC order cuts 3 months off the timeline (Jan 29 2021 → Oct. 30 2020).
- Proposed work plan cuts 2 months from the task force (Oct → Aug) and adds a half day of meeting time.
- FERC added scope: hybrids, generic limited duration resources, and hydro
 - Developing generic ELCC provisions is arguably the heaviest lift
